

Key Instant Recall Facts KSI



By the end of each half term, children should know the following facts and be able to instantly recall them:

	Year	Year 2
Autumn I	Recite the number names in order to 50 and beyond.	Recite the numbers in order to 100. I know number bonds to 10. I know number bonds to 20.
Autumn 2	I can add 0 or 1 to a number. I can add 2 to a number.	I know doubles and halves of numbers to 20. I know near doubles to 10. I can use bridging (add to next 10 first) and compensation for addition to 10 + 10.
Spring I	I know number bonds to 10. I know odd and even numbers to 20.	Count in 2s. I know the multiplication and division facts for the 2 times tables up to 12 x 2.
Spring 2	Count in 2s to 20. Count in 10s to 100. Count in 5s to 50.	Count in 5s and 10s. I know multiplication and division facts for the 5 and 10-times tables up to 12 x 5 and 12 x 10.
Summer I	I can add 10 to a number.	Count in 3s to 36.
Summer 2	I know near doubles to 5.	To begin to know the 3 times tables up to 3 x 10.
Vocabulary	Bridging - Add to the next ten first. E.g. 8+9 so 8 + 2 = 10 and then 10 + 7 = 17 Compensation - Rounding one number to the nearest 10 to make the calculation easier. E.g. 9 + 8 becomes 10 (+1) + 7 (-1) = 17
