Revised return to school arrangements following Prime Minister Lock-down announcement 8.00pm 4.1.2021

Dear Parents, carers

Following the statement this evening from the Prime Minister please see below the revised arrangements for children returning to school that take immediate effect from 5.1.2021.

School will be open for Key worker/Critical workers and vulnerable children - If you consider yourself to be a Key Worker/Critical worker you can send your child to school from tomorrow. School will be sending out a short survey tomorrow to all parents/carers so we can update our list of Key Worker/Critical Worker children in school.

Breakfast Club will be open as usual tomorrow morning but only for children of Key workers/Critical Workers and Vulnerable children. School will try and maintain its Breakfast Club provision as we realise how useful this is for working parents. School will review this decision once we know more about the demand for this service from our parents.

Drop-off and Collection times for Key Worker/Critical Worker and vulnerable children – Drop off times will be 8.45am and collection times will remain as per our return to school guidance published this afternoon. Children will line up socially distanced once they have had their temperature check. Parents need to remain in their cars at all times.

Temperature checks – will be in place for all children entering school site from 5.1.2021 as per our return to school guidance published this afternoon.

Face coverings – Must be worn by all parents/carers and young people over the age of 11 years entering the school premises with immediate effect as per our return to school guidance published this afternoon.

Remote Learning – Work will continue to be posted on Class Dojo tomorrow for all children not attending school whilst we transition to using Office 365 Education this week. All parents will receive an e-mail tomorrow with their child/rens log-in details for Office 365 Education. School will also be preparing a short video for parents/carers to introduce you to Office 365 Education which will be shared with you all this week as part of the transition phase.

School would like to thank you all in anticipation of your continued co-operation and support.
