

Literacy:

- Recognise own name.
- Continue with Phase 1 Letters and Sounds to learn about the alphabet
- Begin to learn Phase 2 sounds
- Develop early reading skills.
- Mark make using a variety of writing tools.
- Talk about the marks they have made.

Religious Education:

- Understand and make the sign of the cross.
- Learn about Baptism
- Say our daily prayers and learn our new Lenten prayers
- Learn about Lent and Easter
- Join in with liturgies

Mathematics:

- Say number names in order to 5/10.
- Name and identify 2D shapes.
- Touch count objects and say the total.
- Copy and create patterns.
- Join in with number rhymes.
- Begin to recognise numbers to 5/10
- Understand big/small and begin to order objects by size.
- Understand full, half full and empty
- Join in with number rhymes

We will be learning to...

Communication and Language:

- Talk in sentences
- Take turns during discussions and listen and respond to what other people are saying.
- Talk about ourselves and our families.
- Join in with nursery rhymes.
- Show understanding of prepositions such as 'under', 'on top', 'behind'.
- Respond to simple instructions.
- Listen to stories with increasing attention and recall.

Physical Development:

- Hold a pencil with correct grip and with good control.
- Use scissors safely and correctly.
- Imitate drawing simple shapes and lines.
- Begin to copy and form recognisable letters using correct formation
- Handle tools, objects and materials safely
- Show increasing control over an object by pushing, patting, throwing, catching or kicking it.
- Clearly communicate their need for the toilet and attending to these needs most of the time themselves.
- Put our own coats on.

Expressive Arts and Design:

- Create paintings and collage using a variety of media
- Learn a variety of songs and rhymes.
- Role play with different objects.
- Enjoy joining in with dancing and ring games.
- Play cooperatively as part of a group to develop and act out a story.
- Create simple representations of events, people and objects.

PSED:

- Follow school and nursery rules.
- Take turns and share with each other.
- Be independent when going to the toilet, washing and drying our hands.
- Make lots of friends and resolve conflict.
- Ask for help when needed.
- Initiate conversations and begin to take account of what others say.
- Understand that own actions affect other people, for example, they may become upset or try to comfort another child when they realise they have upset them.
