Our school has a safeguarding policy for staff, families and governors. This child friendly policy is designed for you.



It will help you decide what could be a problem and where you can get help. You might want to talk to someone about something that is upsetting you.



We have people in school who are trained to help you. It is important that you know where you can get help if you are worried or unhappy with something.






We will always listen
