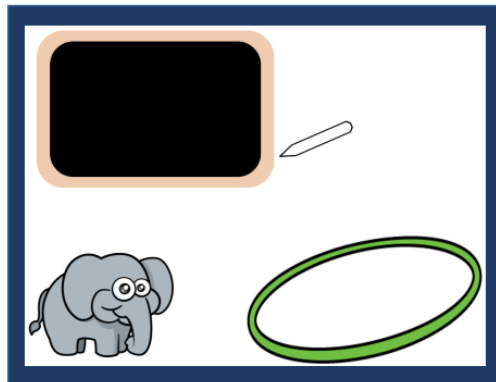

You will need a target, such as a hoop, and three objects to throw.



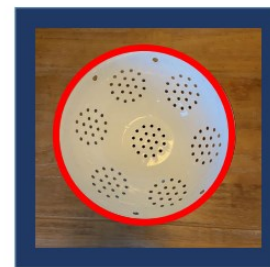
How many landed inside the hoop? How many landed outside the hoop?
