School Meal and Mid- Morning Snack Arrangements for return to school 2.6.2020

Dear parents, carers

As a follow-up from Headteachers letter dated 26.5.2020 school has put in place the following control measures and procedures to ensure the safe provision of school meals for your child on their return to school.

- **NO packed lunches, snacks or food are to be brought into school by children.**
School will provide all children attending school with a free, healthy school dinner and mid-morning snack
- **School Meal menu (please see page 2 for menu)** – Our School catering team and Catering Consultant have prepared a healthy, tasty school meal menu for children returning to school. School will be reintroducing parental ordering of meals via ParentMail during the phased return.
- **Ordering your child's school meal via Parentmail** - Parents will need to order their child's school dinner choice via ParentMail in advance of them attending school. **Please note all school meal orders need to be placed by Midnight on the day before your child requires a School Meal**, as school will be using those orders to prepare your child's school meal the following day. School will send out separate e-mail instructions by the end of this week with regards to instructions on how to book your child's meal on ParentMail.
- **Preparation of School Meals** – Your child's school dinner will be prepared based on the choices you have selected on ParentMail. Your child's school meal will be labelled with their names and packaged in disposable wrappings ready to be handed out at lunchtimes.
- **Service of School Meals** – Your child's school meal will be served to them in their classroom. Children will be expected to wash their hands before and after eating their school meal. All packaging will be disposable, and children will need to maintain social distancing and remain sitting at their allotted table whilst they eat their lunch.
- **Free School Meals** – If your child is eligible for Free School Meals and has been receiving the Edenred e-vouchers for Free School Meals once they return to school they will no longer be eligible for the e-vouchers as school will now be providing them with a Free School Meal. If your child is eligible for Free School Meals and has **not** returned to school they will continue to receive their Edenred e-vouchers as normal.
- **Mid-morning snacks** – All children in school will be provided with either a piece of fruit or a healthy cookie at mid-morning break which school will provide free of charge.
- **Allergens** – School will continue to ensure that food standards are maintained and that your child is not given any food products which may cause them an allergic reaction.

School has put in the above control measures and systems to maintain social distancing across school, reduce the number of contacts your child/staff have outside of their 'Bubble Group' and to maintain effective infection control and hygiene measures.
