Understanding the World

When you go on your autumn
walk, ask a grown up if you can
use a camera or a phone to take
some photographs. Look at and
talk about all the different pictures you have taken.

Literacy-Reading

 Our story focus is 'Owl Babies', ask your child to talk about the story.
 Can they tell you who the characters are in the story? What happened to them? Can they repeat the familiar phrase from the story?



Expressive Arts and Design

 Go on an Autumn walk and collect some Autumn leaves. Talk about all the different colours of the leaves you have collected. Use the leaves to make a picture or a collage.

Physical Development

 Help your child to develop their fine motor skills by encouraging them to make snips in paper with scissors, and develop a comfortable grip when holding writing tools
