



### RE

- As we learn about Celebrations, talk to an adult about all the different ways we can celebrate special occasions with family and friends. Do you have a photograph that you can share with your class?

### Communication and Language

- Talk to an adult and tell them about the stories we are reading to do with our topic Under the Sea-Which story is your favourite?
- The Rainbow Fish learnt how to be a good friend. Talk to an adult at home about the different ways to be a good friend.



### Maths



- Teach your family the song '1, 2, 3, 4, 5, once I caught a fish alive'. Don't forget to teach them the actions too!
- Play a game of 'starfish' with your fingers. Adults say a number to five and then you show that number

### Literacy-Writing

- Encourage children to hear and say to the initial sounds of different sea creatures under the sea, e.g. fish, octopus, jellyfish, starfish etc
- Show your family how you are learning to write your name. Can you remember the rhyme for each of the letters?

## Nursery Summer 2

### Topic

Oh I do like to be beside the seaside

### Understanding the World

- Use a paint/drawing program on the iPad or tablet to draw pictures of sea creatures
- Ask an adult if you can print the picture to show your class, or ask the adult if they can send your picture via email to [nursery@st-modwens.staffs.sch.uk](mailto:nursery@st-modwens.staffs.sch.uk). Your teacher can then share it on the class computer

### Literacy-Reading

- Hen, den, ten are rhyming words. Can you think of any other rhyming words? E.g. words that rhyme with 'cat', 'dog', 'tin'
- Use books to find out a fact about a creature that lives under the sea. We can then share our facts with the rest of the class



### Expressive Arts and Design

- Can you draw or paint a picture of your favourite sea creature? What colours would you need to use?
- Can you make a model of a sea creature? Try using playdough, a paper plate, cardboard boxes or tubes..

### Physical Development

- Practise using scissors to make snips in around the bottom of cardboard tubes. These strips can be curled back to make the legs of an octopus or a jelly fish. The tubes can then be decorated
