- Learn a poem to recite to the class that has a Greek theme or is based on a fable/myth.
- Turn a myth into a cartoon, for example, Theseus and the Minotaur. Use lots of speech bubbles.

Art

- Make a Spartan helmet or design a shield. 
- Make a collage using pictures from holiday brochures or the internet showing ancient buildings and interesting places to visit in Greece.

Health and Wellbeing

- Research Greek food. How is it different to traditional English food? You could recreate your own Greek dish. Can you create a recipe suitable for Hercules? 
- Timed sprints in preparation for an Olympic games.
